AT:

Helps you exhaustively list all possibilities and risks with regards to actions and stakeholders. It helps to focus on the details, but it also misses the big picture. It also encourage adding new categories, one can always divides things into more parts. It helps to raise issues, but doesn't help to prioritize those issues.

Collab is the collaborative version of AT.

OLE:

The OLE is a questionnaire that helps people to identify and answer ethics conflicts within different groups of people (and organizations). This method is straightforward. However it forces your to think about different issues without giving a way to solve it.

HA:

The tool is limited to the situation for one stakeholder and it categorizes the autonomous and heteronomous ways of thinking into 4 different sub-groups. It is a good tool to discuss the autonomous and heteronomous thinking, and the autonomous thinking can be analyzed by AT. However it is hard to distinguish ways of thinking, and the form itself is hard to fill in, due to the structures of the sub-groups.
